

affilinet's UK Privacy Policy

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully – this is a legal document. Once you register with affilinet or sign up for any of affilinet's services in the UK you will be deemed to have read and consented to our use of your personal data as set out in this UK Privacy Policy. You will also be deemed to have read and accepted this UK Privacy Policy.

If you consent now but later change your mind, you may at any time withdraw your consent by notifying us at uksupport@affili.net. If you withdraw your consent, affilinet will close your account and stop using your personal data as soon as is practicable. You may also change or correct any of your details at any time by sending an e-mail to the above address.

1) Personal Data

What we mean by personal data

When we refer to personal data in this UK Privacy Policy, we mean data that can identify you as an individual, such as your name, address or email address. By personal data we do not mean general, statistical, or anonymised information.

Why we collect data

affilinet will collect personal information about you which you give to us when you register to use our services. The provision of the services to you may also require us to store details of your transactions, together with details of your financial information. We will periodically review your personal information to ensure that we do not keep it for longer than is necessary.

affilinet needs to collect personal data about you in order to provide you with the services and to personalise aspects of our overall service to you offered on www.affili.net and to administer your affilinet account. By collecting personal data about you, affilinet will ensure that only you can use your affilinet account. We may also compile statistical databases to improve and help run www.affili.net.

What data do we collect

When you register with affilinet as a Program Supplier or a Partner, we will collect the following personal data from you:

- a) your full name;
- b) your home address and (if different) your business address;
- c) your web and email addresses;
- d) bank or payment details;
- e) VAT or tax reference number;
- f) current telephone numbers (mobile and fixed line); and
- g) credit card details.

How we use your personal data

affilinet may use your personal data to build a working relationship with you in relation to your use of the services provided at www.affili.net or to improve the services or affilinet platform generally.

affilinet may also from time to time send you emails notifying you of any updates to www.affili.net. If you want to stop receiving these emails, please follow the instructions on the emails.

affilinet may (or a third party we directly appoint to assist us may) use your personal data to inform you about affilinet offers and services, which are useful for the partner's or program supplier's business or to manage online surveys with which we are able to improve and fulfil our partner's or program supplier's requirements.

Personal data will only be stored and used for the purposes outlined above and will not be used for direct marketing or market research purposes without your consent.

Who we share your personal data with

Please be aware that once you use our website or the affili.net services, you will be regarded as having given your consent to us disclosing your personal information to the following parties:

- ⇒ our card processor, bank, in order to process your transactions and maintain accounts;
- ⇒ other third parties either where necessary for those third parties to provide additional products or services requested by you or with your prior consent; and

In addition, affili.net reserves the right to communicate such personal data it holds to third parties which seek the disclosure of it, and which make a legally compliant request for its disclosure. affili.net also reserves the right to communicate your personal data to the relevant authorities if we believe that you are involved in illegal activities or commit any breach of this UK privacy policy, which would justify such disclosure.

Except as provided for above, personal data will not be forwarded to third parties without your consent.

2) Non-Personal Data

Even if you have not registered with affili.net, non-personal data may be collected whilst you are visiting [www.affili.net]. These data cannot be used to identify you as an individual (for example information collected could include Internet browser information, computer system information, domain and name of the website form which a user came, number of visits, average time the user stays on our site and further sites visited). We use this information for evaluating and optimising the content and functionality of our website for your benefit.

3) Cookies

When logging on to secured sections of [www.affili.net], the site uses a feature called a Cookie. A Cookie is a file that is sent to your Internet web browser from affili.net's computers and stored on your computer's hard drive. A Cookie assigns a unique identification code to your computer. The use of cookies is an industry standard.

On this site, cookies are used to track and maintain continuity of web session such as the registration process, they also help us track visitors as they go through this site indicating whether or not we have repeat customers, if so where they are coming from and whether or not we are delivering the right quality product to our customers. Cookies also allow you to back click to earlier registration pages viewed by you and help us improve our content and services. We also use cookies to track activity from a publisher's web site to an advertiser's website for the purpose of recording valid clicks, click-outs, lead and sales.

Cookies identify a user's computer but they do not contain any personally identifiable information. They are utilised by many other websites to benefit their users by enabling provision of a personalised service.

You may set your Internet web browser to notify you when you receive a cookie or to prevent cookies from being sent to you. If you prevent a cookie from being sent, you may limit the functionality of this site our service and our site may not provide you with any service at all. 4) Children

affilinet will not knowingly collect personal and individual data of children in any way nor will we forward this data to any third party or let any third party have an insight in these data.

5) Security

Keeping information about you secure is very important to us. We take security very seriously.

However, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be totally secure. As a result, whilst we strive to protect your personal information, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information which you send to us, and you do so at your own risk.

6) Links

affilinet is not responsible and should not be held to account or liable for links to other websites, other websites content or their data protection regulations.

7) Individual access

Upon written request, affilinet will inform you whether or not it holds personal data about you, and will provide you with the opportunity to review the personal data it holds and request the update or modification of the same or request its deletion in accordance with this UK Privacy Policy. affilinet may charge a £10.00 fee to cover its costs in providing such data to you.

8) Transferring your information abroad

Information supplied by you to us will only be transferred outside of the European Economic Area by us or our agents for the purpose of performing contractual obligations to you, or when you have given your prior consent to such transfer.

9) Changes to the Policy

We reserve the right to change this UK Privacy Policy at any time. Any changes will be recorded on Any revised UK Privacy Policy will be placed on this site 30 days before it becomes effective, on the revised UK Privacy Policy. Otherwise we will not notify you of these changes and to this end we strongly encourage you to check this UK Policy frequently.
